**C—Confession –I am sorry...**  
**Prayers for Ourselves**

8am- **Praise:** for a new day and walk with Jesus

9am-**Work/School:** thank God for your job/opportunity to learn, pray for your co-workers/classmates.

10am-**Repentance:** ask 1) God to reveal your sins, 2) forgiveness for your sins and 3) for God's help to change your sinful ways.

11am- **Learning:** that you would grow in knowledge of God's Word and His Kingdom for the life of the world.

12pm-**Spiritual Growth:** that you would know Jesus as your best friend and you would grow in love, joy, peace, patience, etc.

1pm-**Guidance:** Seek, listen and respond to God's call to be the person He created you to become.

2pm- **Hope and Vision:** a strong sense that God is with you and that He has plans for your life.

3pm-**Health:** thanksgiving for your body, protection from illness, pain, healing touch.

4pm-**Family:** spouse, children, parents, siblings, grandparents, other relatives.

5pm-**Finances:** for wisdom, generosity, blessing, contentment.

6pm- **Friends:** thank God for your friends, ask Him to bless them, and for you to be a good friend.

7pm-**Activities:** that God would work in you and through you in your hobbies, volunteering and other activities to glorify Him.

8pm-**Rest:** for good rhythms of work and rest, a good night's sleep, and God's protection.

**6pm- Local/Global:** God would use us to bless others and help them know Jesus.

**7pm-** God help me to listen to your voice and give me a servant's heart to obey and trust in your Word.

**8pm-** Praise the Lord, all nations! Extol Him all peoples! ...the faithfulness of the Lord endures forever!

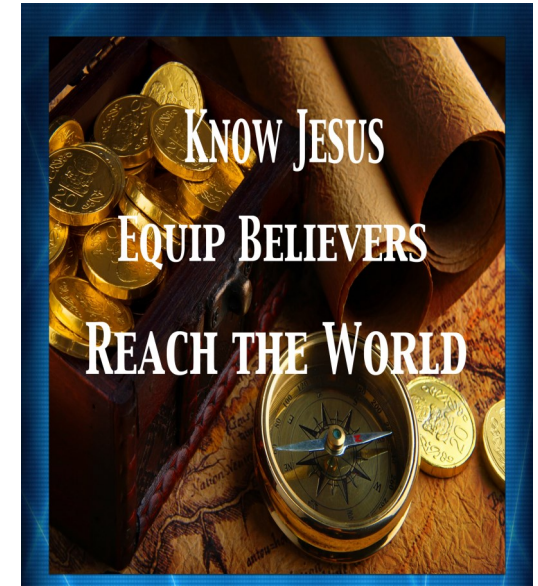
Each day there is a theme and items to pray for each hour from 8am-8pm .

*Utilize this guide to nurture your prayers throughout 2019 .*

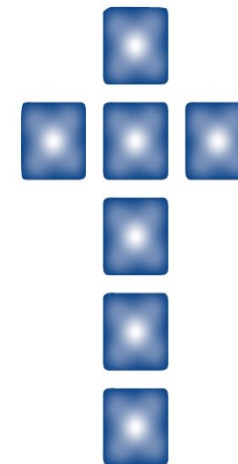
Take the invitation. God is listening.

While there are three intentional days of prayer, God desires that *every day is a day of prayer*. "Pray without ceasing," God tells us in 1 Thessalonians 5:17. Here are some ideas to make prayer a regular part of your day.

- Start the morning in prayer. Before you get out of bed, say good morning to God and thank Him for a new day.
- Pray with your spouse and/or kids before leaving for work/school, asking that God would bless their day.
- Pray before each task, meeting, or class, asking that God would guide you and give you strength.
- Pray at each meal, thanking God providing for your needs.
- Whenever you hear a siren, stop and pray for those involved.
- When you see something beautiful, thank God for His creation.
- When you feel stressed, pause and pray. Let God's peace rule in your heart.
- Pray with your kids/spouse before bedtime, thanking God for the day, asking forgiveness for your sins, and asking God to give restful sleep.
